




Africa in context: vast continent and growing potential



- Increased income and employment.








The Tanzania chapter: Sales regions







- Lake Zone (George Upina): Kagera, Mwanza, Mara regions, 67'546 km2 (NL+BE)
- CSS: Central Seed Store RZ Arusha, receive M-Pesa payments, release the seed, send by plane
- RZ CoE: office, Point of Distribution, demo, training, meeting & discussion








Sales FY 2016-2017 Transaction by mode (In % by Total Value)


